

Aftercare & Maintenance

Granite Components (Exterior Environment)

Citysquared recommend the cleaning process is undertaken approximately once every 3 to 6 months, depending on the installation environment, to maintain optimum appearance.

<p>1.0</p> <p>Removal of loose, superficial debris can be carried out with a pressure washer.</p> <p>Citysquared recommend testing a small inconspicuous area initially to gauge the correct pressure for your particular granite and the nature of the soiling.</p> <p>Pressure washing can also be carried out with a detergent where grime build up is more apparent, particularly in high road traffic environments.</p>	<p>2.0</p> <p>For stain causing organic debris (bird droppings, leaf mulch) an acid solution may be required. Care must be taken to ensure it is used in a suitable environment.</p> <p>For stubborn stains more than one application of solution may be required.</p> <p>Follow the manufacturer's instructions and ensure that all surfaces are rinsed thoroughly following the application of an acid.</p> <p>Citysquared recommend goggles and gloves are worn when applying the cleaning solution.</p> <p>HMK R55 is recommended as a suitable Granite cleaner.</p>
