Citysquared recommend the cleaning process is undertaken approximately every 3 months, depending on the installation environment, to maintain optimum appearance. Periodic touch up painting may be required.

Clean component surface with a mild detergent and warm water. Check detergent is non-abrasive by testing on an inconspicuous area, to ensure that gloss levels/finishes are not damaged. Use a lint free cloth and wring out well. Change the water frequently. Dry with a clean soft cloth.	To repair scuffs and light scratches, buff the area with a fine Scotch-Brite™ pad to flatten the paint surface. Paint over the area using a brush appropriate in size to the damage. Use enough paint to give an even coverage. Paint may be sourced from your local paint supplier, or alternatively Citysquared are happy to source this for you.

To repaint larger areas a gloss roller may be more appropriate. Use enough paint to give an even coverage.	For chips and deep scratches, use fine wet & dry paper to smooth out. Remove any dust from the area with a clean dry brush. Follow steps 2 or 3 to cover the damaged area. Observe the paint manufacturers product information sheet for health and safety advice. Citysquared always recommend suitable protective clothing and gloves are worn.
